SCA Association started implementing in NES since it was legally registered in 2015, which the projects implemented by SCA Association through INGOs and UN agencies as following:

1st Health projects

2016 – 2017

- The locations which SCA Association implemented in:

(Amuda) and (Darbasiyah), Total number of BNF reached by 2 PHCs: 74880 BNFs.

Men: 19968, Women: 24960, Girls: 16848 and Boys: 13104.

The project implemented in 2 locations which SCA Association established 2 Primary health centers in both locations provided the health services for the people for 1 year which the clinicals were available in those 2 PHCs to provide services such as: counseling, treatment, drugs, lab tests, and managing the chronic diseases, in addition to raising awareness of BNFs regarding infants and young children feeding IYCF and facilities on reproductive health (RH) in emergencies as well as Pediatrician, Cardiologist and Gynecologist.

2nd Health project

2016 – 2022

- The location which SCA Association implemented in: (Darbasiyah), Kola

Yearly the PHCs provide health services for more than 47000 BNFs .

The project implemented in 1 location which SCA Association established one Primary health center and started providing the health services for the people for 6 year which the clinicals were available in the PHC to provide services such as: counseling, treatment, drugs, lab tests, and managing the chronic diseases, in addition to raising awareness of BNFs regarding infants and young children feeding IYCF and facilities on reproductive health (RH) in emergencies as well as Pediatrician, Cardiologist and Gynecologist.

3rd Health project

2019 – 2022

- The location which SCA Association implemented in: (Raqqa and Al-Hasakeh).

Tele-Microbiology Labs Facilities:

Specialized service providing Bacterial culture and susceptibility tests for bacteria-resistant strains. as well as playing role in Tuberculosis (TB) program for diagnosis and more specialized tests for resistant strains of TB, these services are provided by highly trained technicians in direct cooperation of consultant experts. The current capacity for each facility is capable to provide up to 300 full diagnosis tests per month, with the possibility to increase the capacity to cover all referral cases from all NES locations.

The tele microbiology system tailored had established already to serve two locations in Syria (Raqqa and Al-Hasakeh).

The system is connecting two workstations physically existing in hard-to-reach areas inside Syria with a virtual headquarters based abroad. The workflow includes:

1. in situ preparation of samples,
2. acquisition of digitalized results,
3. transmission of the results,
4. remote display, interpretation, And analysis.

1st (FSL) Agricultural project :1 rounds (1 projects)

2015 – 2016

- The location which SCA Association implemented in: (Al-Hasakeh).

SCA Association started with conducting survey to target the most vulnerable

SCA Association distributed agricultural tools

fuel and Fertilizers step by step for the farmers through vouchers in first 3 months.

Then SCA Association started with training the farmers in following subjects with

providing technical support and advising services:

- Agricultural quarantine and product quality control
- Renewable and alternative energy

- Irrigation systems and water management
- Good Agricultural Practices (GAP)
- Value chains approach and principles
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
- Winter crops management

The farmers start planting and SCA Association supervising all steps, on weekly basis with Fertilizers distribution and follow up the diseases of cultivated vegetables in addition to watering till the harvesting.
